Sarah studied at Byam Shaw and Camberwell School of Art, London, graduating in 1981. She was the winner of the W&N Young Artists Award in 1986 and her first solo show was in 1988 with Austin Desmond Fine Art, Berkshire. She has since exhibited regularly both in the UK and abroad. She also teaches at Sunningwell School of Art near Oxford and has run workshops for Art in Action. Sarah has become well known for her still life paintings which are based on close observation and strong drawing. They are quiet meditative paintings that use colour to explore, organise and define the form and space. She lives and works in Oxford where she has a studio in an old punt building workshop.
